Cognitive Assessment

-Formal IQ Testing

A cognitive assessment can also be referred to as an IQ assessment, or a psycho-educational assessment. Cognitive assessment is important in helping schools, families, and individuals gain a deeper insight into their strengths and weaknesses in intellectual functioning. **Cognitive assessment is necessary for diagnosis of intellectual giftedness or intellectual impairment.**

Blooming Bees Psychology offers cognitive assessment for:

- Children 6 years to 16 years, 11 months using the Wechsler Intelligence Scales for Children, Fifth Edition (WISC-V Australian and New Zealand Adaptation).
- Adults 17-90 years of age using the Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scales, Fourth Edition (WAIS-IV).

Academic Achievement Testing

-Learning Disorders and Learning Styles

Learning assessments help to pinpoint students unique learning styles, and their strengths and challenges, thus helping educators tailor their teaching methods to cater to individual needs. They provide the foundation for personalized learning plans that optimize academic success. Moreover, learning assessments empower students by highlighting their cognitive strengths and offering strategies to overcome obstacles, thus improving self-confidence and motivation. Learning assessments can also be used to diagnose a specific learning disorders such as dyslexia, dysgraphia, and dyscalculia.

An educational assessment tests an individuals' academic achievement using the Wechsler Individual Achievement Test, Third Edition (WIAT-III). By comparing the WIAT-III results with the individual's cognitive IQ (measured by the WISC-V), we can determine whether the individual is achieving academically in line with their potential.

The cost of this assessment includes administration of the WISC-V and of the WIAT-III, and a written report detailing results and recommendations.

ADHD Assessment

Psychological assessments, particularly those that assess ADHD and learning difficulties, play an important role in the lives of individuals, especially school-aged students. These assessments serve as essential compasses in navigating the complexities of attention and learning. For individuals struggling with ADHD, these evaluations offer clarity by diagnosing the condition accurately, ensuring they receive the appropriate support and interventions. Receiving an ADHD diagnosis can help an individual understand why their brains work the way they do, which can be a major relief of anxiety, confusion, and poor self-esteem.

When choosing to do an ADHD assessment, you may opt to use just the Conners 4 and the Behaviour Rating Inventory of Executive Function (BRIEF) as a screening tool. It can then be determined whether cognitive and academic achievement assessment is required to confirm diagnosis and will enable the provision of more substantial feedback on neurocognitive and learning strengths and weaknesses.

ASD Assessment

-Autism Level Assessment

Understandably, there can be some hesitation around doing an autism assessment and giving children/teens a "label". However, if there have been any concerns or flags raised it is strongly recommended to pursue assessment. Receiving a formal diagnosis gives access to funding, provides essential information to schools who will be able to more effectively support the individual, and allows for both the individual and their family to gain fundamental insights into how they process the world. Even if the individual is assessed and is NOT diagnosed with autism, a thorough assessment process still has immense value: it can help reveal the specific reasons for an individual's challenges and the most effective support for them. Knowledge is power.

Blooming Bees Psychology conducts the "gold standard" of ASD assessment using the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS-2) and the Autism Diagnostic Interview- Revised (ADI-R). This is paired with a full Cognitive Assessment, the Autism Spectrum Rating Scales (ASRS), completed by both parent and teacher, and any other assessments/screening tools that may be helpful in targeting and understanding ASD criteria.
